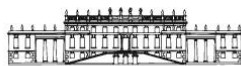

**Flu Vaccination Requirements:**

- a) *An initial Primary Course of two vaccinations must be given; the second vaccination must be administered within 21-92 days of the first vaccination.*
- b) *The first booster must be administered within 7 calendar months following the date of administration of the second vaccination of the Primary Course.*
- c) *In accordance with FEI regulations, all horses attending the Event at Bramham must have received a booster within 6 months +21 days (and not within 7 days) before arrival at the Event.*
- d) *Horses may attend Bramham 7 days after receiving the second vaccination of the primary course.*
- e) *Horses that have received the Primary Course prior to 1 January 2005 are not required to fulfil the requirement for the first booster, providing there has not been an interval of more than 12 months between each of their subsequent annual booster vaccinations and they have received a booster within 6 months +21 days (and not within 7 days) before arrival at the Event.*

**Entries:**

Open online at [www.equoevents.com](http://www.equoevents.com). Postal entries will also be accepted. Cheques to be made payable to 'Bramham Horse Trials LLP'. Please send your entry form and cheque to Horse Trials Office, Bramham Park, Wetherby, West Yorkshire, LS23 6ND. Entries are confined to horses registered with British Showjumping and must be ridden by adult, associate or junior members in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79. Rule 77 applies to all classes. Entries will not be accepted without the correct registration numbers. **Closing date for entries is 20<sup>th</sup> May 2020.**

**Times:**

All are stated on the schedule. Please note that times are approximate. Some classes may run concurrently.

**Drawn Order:**

All competitors must declare to the secretary each day at least **one hour** before the start of the class. All classes will be strictly drawn order. **Details of drawn order will be posted on the web site ([www.bramham-horse.co.uk](http://www.bramham-horse.co.uk)) approx 48hrs before the show.**

**Substitutions:**

These will be permitted in accordance with Rule 79.4.

**Refunds and Withdrawals:**

These will be permitted in accordance with Rule 79.5. Any withdrawals prior to the event will result in complementary entrance tickets being invalidated.

**Admission:**

E-tickets will be used again this year for both vehicles and people. All e-tickets will be scanned upon entry to the event; please do not forget them as entry cannot be permitted without a valid e-ticket. Tickets can only be scanned once. **Each accepted postal entry form or online transaction** will be issued with one vehicle e-ticket to cover the horse box/trailer, two personal admission e-tickets per rider and one further personal admission e-ticket per additional horse. Tickets will be day-specific. No further tickets will be given free of charge. Any vehicle or person without an e-ticket will be charged the full on-gate price. If you require extra tickets please purchase them online at [www.bramham-horse.co.uk/tickets](http://www.bramham-horse.co.uk/tickets) or indicate on your entry form in the space provided.

**Hard Hats:**

Hard hats must be worn **at all times**. Standard to be in accordance with Rule 101.3.

**Conditions:**

The Organisers retain the right to refuse entry and to amend details of the schedule with prior permission from British Showjumping.

**Prizes:**

General Rule 76.6 applies to all classes. Prize money must be collected from the show jumping office on the day of the show.

**Stallions:**

No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury. See Rule 82.19

**Unaccompanied Competitors**

Unaccompanied Competitors must provide the Show Organiser a contact telephone number in case of an emergency. See Rule 31.5

**Conditions:**

The Organiser retains the right to refuse entry and to amend details of the schedule without prior warning.

**Location:**

Use the post code LS23 6NB. Upon your final approach to the Park please turn off your sat-nav and follow all event traffic signs carefully and accordingly.

**VAT:**

All entry fees include VAT at 20%, Bramham Park LLP VAT registration 829 0153 37, VAT invoices will be issued upon request.
