Bramham glamping is an exclusive, private site located in the heart of Bramham Horse Trials. Glamping is a luxury way to enjoy the horse trials, whilst having all the amenities.

Enjoy a peaceful night's sleep before a day full of action.

OPENING AND CLOSING TIMES

Glamping ticket holders may access the camp site from **12.00 pm on Wednesday 5th June**. Please note, there is no movement on site between 3:30pm – 5:30pm due to the First Horse Inspection. You can arrive either before this time, or after, but not during. Check in will be open until 7pm. If you do not plan to arrive on Wednesday, please call the office to discuss this.

Please do not enter any tents without first checking in with the glamp site Steward; your tent is pre allocated.

The Glamp site will close at **6pm on Sunday 9th June**. Please ensure your tent is clear of all your belongings.

TICKETS



Please have your e-ticket printed and/or ready to present upon arrival at Bramham. **This e-ticket may only be used once.** Once at the glamping site you will exchange your e-ticket for a glamp site pack. This pack will contain:

- Glamping wrist bands for the number of people booked in your tent, these will allow access to the Members area.
- One vehicle Glamping pass.
- Invitations to the Thursday Night Cocktail Party.

Only those who have purchased glamping tickets can stay on the glamp site.

All campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

WHAT TO EXPECT



Your tent will include the following amenities:

- Welcome hamper
- 1 x plug socket (we recommend bringing an extension lead plus any adapters you may need to charge your phone/tablet)
- Bed with mattress, linen, bedding (13.5 tog), throw and pillow
- Bedside table with lantern and plant
- Outside Solar Fairy Lights
- Waste Bin
- Travel Slippers
- Wi-fi in the glamping field (we recommend downloading any films and the Bramham App before your arrival as usage may be limited)

Only **one** vehicle is permitted for each tent. There is a designated parking area for Glamping.



GETTING TO BRAMHAM PARK



Entry to the park will be through North Lodge (**LS23 6NB**) between the hours of 6.00am and 11.00 pm. Upon your final approach to the Park please observe all yellow event traffic management signs for 'Officials'. To exit please follow the one-way system.

Anyone wishing to enter or exit the park out of these hours must do so via Bowcliffe Gate (**LS23 6LR**) and follow the night route. Anyone without a valid pass will not be permitted entry.

There is a strict speed limit of 20 mph inside the park unless otherwise indicated

MOVEMENT ON SITE

The Organiser has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of all present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. Instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards must be obeyed at all times.

FACILITIES



Water, toilets and showers will be available to use from Wednesday evening. The nearest shop is Bramham Village Shop or Wetherby for supermarkets.

FOOD AND DRINK



The Member's Bar will remain open in the evening with free access to glampers, offering a limited selection of food. Members will be shut on Sunday evening. A good selection of food and drink will be available from catering concessions during event hours.


No unaccompanied under 18s will be allowed in the Member's areas during the evening.

CAMP FIRES, BBQS, SMOKING & CANDLES




Unfortunately, we cannot allow campfires or barbeques as the risks involved are too great within the glamping area. There will be a BBQ available in the Members bar on some evenings. Strictly no smoking or lighting of candles inside the tents.

PERIOD OF QUIET



Please be considerate to other campers. We ask that everyone observes a period of quiet between the hours of 11.00 pm and 7.00 am.

ACCIDENTS AND FIRST AID




If an accident occurs on the glamp site please alert a Glamp Site Steward. First-aiders will be on site whilst competitors are riding and there will be overnight cover on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.

DISABLED FACILITIES

There are no disabled showers or toilets at the glamp site. Event Mobility will be present and mobility scooters may be hired with them. Contact Event Mobility at <http://www.eventmobility.org.uk> for more information.

DOGS



All dogs are welcome (sadly not puppies), though they must be on a lead, under control and attached to their owner at all times. All dogs must be cleared up after and waste disposed of in bins provided, or otherwise removed from the event site. Dogs should never be left unattended inside locked cars or tents and are not allowed on the beds.

CROSS COUNTRY COURSE

Please do not climb on the jumps or walk anywhere within the string of the cross country course. It has taken many months of hard work to ensure that the course is in top condition for competitors.

VALUABLES

We cannot be held responsible for the loss or damage of any of your property, please ensure you keep your valuables locked in your car. Any damage to the tents or contents will need to be paid for.

The Organiser reserves the right to ask anyone in breach of the above to leave the event, with no right to re-admittance or refund. Please direct any queries to the Glamp Site Stewards.
